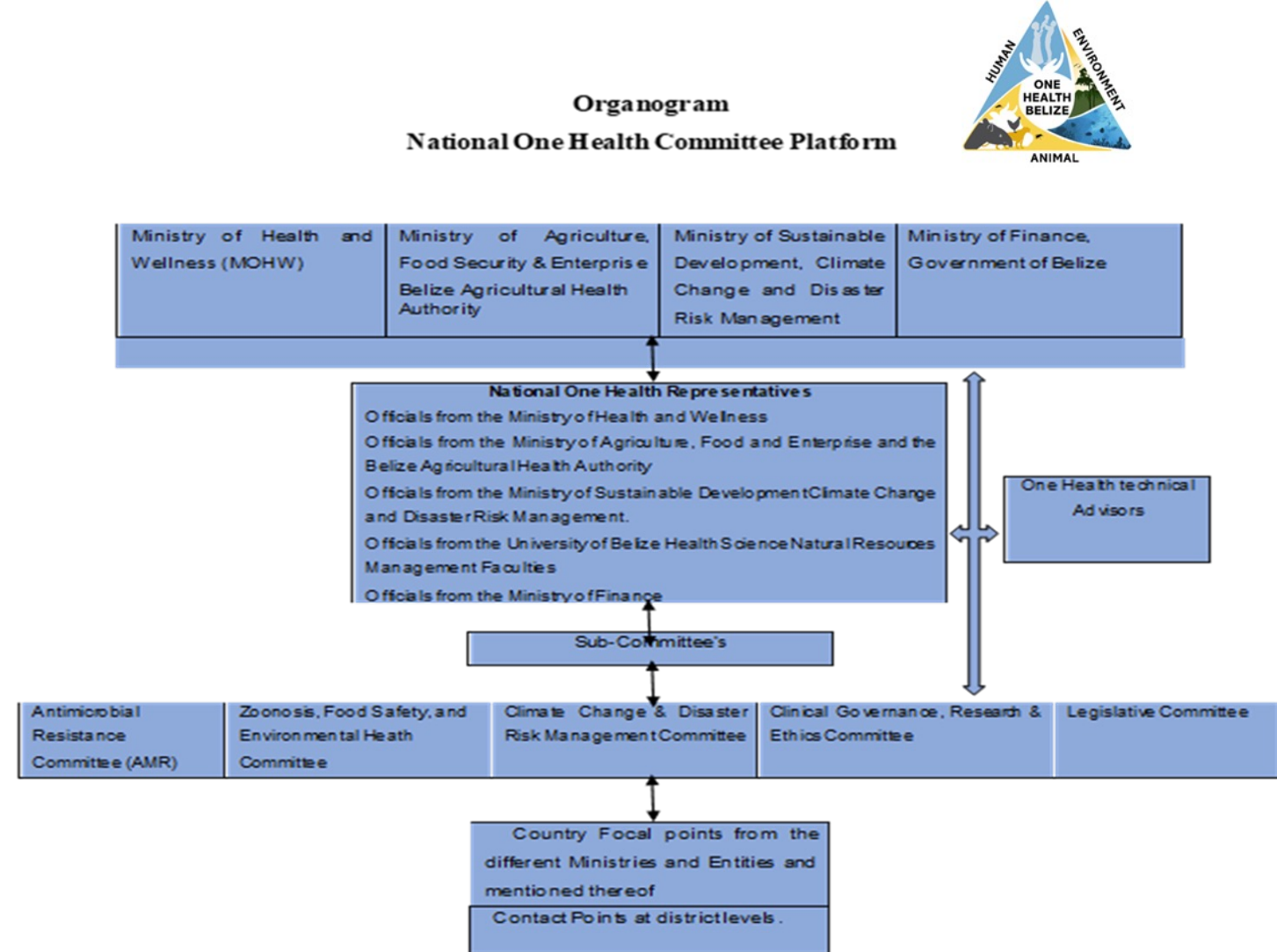


Figure 1. Organogram for the National One Health Committee Platform.
